



Australian Billiards & Snooker Council National Selection Criteria – Under 21

Selection for players to represent Australia will be as per the International Representation Criteria in addition to the selection process below:

- Winner of the Australian Under 21 Snooker Championship, or the Runner Up if the Winner is unable to attend.
- If either of these players are unavailable, and for remaining selections, the Seeding and Selection Committee will reserve the right to select a player, using the results of the Australian Under 21 Snooker Championship.

Note:

- All these selections are subject to the confirmation of the Seeding and Selection committee of the ABSC, in particular with reference to players being of a suitable standard and character to represent Australia.
- Consideration could be given to players unable to contest the Australian Under 21 Snooker Championship if written evidence is provided explaining the circumstances that prevented the player from contesting the Championship.
- Players must meet age requirements for the event – i.e. must be under 21 years of age on 1 January in the year of competition.
